


Year 2 Autumn 2 2017 INDIA!



This half term is always a busy and fun one with the build up to Christmas and all that goes with it. Here is the outline of what your child will be learning about this half term.

what your child

	Theme: India Article 31: The right to relax, play and take part in cultural activities
English	<p>This half term we will be basing our topic of India around the story of 'The Jungle Book'. We will be writing predictions; we are creating our own characters and writing our own versions of the story using our vivid imaginations!</p> <p>There will be a big focus on making exciting sentences this half-term whilst maintaining our basic punctuation and understanding of sentence structure.</p> <p>As always, spellings are very important.</p>
Mathematics	<p>We will begin the half term we will be focusing on our multiplications of 2, 5 and 10 times tables as well as reasoning and word problem solving around this aspect. We will also re-cover our addition and subtraction and be doing some time work too.</p>
Science	<p>Our science this half-term will be based around living things and their habitats. This is ideal for linking to our topic of India and looking at the habitats there.</p>
Computing	<p>In computing the children will be creating weather forecasts and using different software to create graphs linked to India and the UK.</p>
Geography	<p>In Geography we will be looking at the differences between the UK and India. We will also be looking at where these countries lie in relation to other countries and the distances for the equator.</p> <p>We will also be locating landmarks on a map.</p>
Art and D&T	<p>We will be tasting Indian food as well as using our symmetry knowledge to create our own Rangoli Mats. We will also be doing lots of Christmas crafts!</p>
RE	<p>In R.E this half term we will be continuing to learn about Christian Values and also the real meaning of Christmas and God.</p>
PE	<p>In PE we will be learning some classic Indian dance, as well as developing our fitness and healthy lifestyles by doing outdoor child-friendly circuit fun .</p>
Music	<p>In Music we will be looking at how to create different beats linked to India as well as learning the songs for our Christmas play.</p>
