	Theme: The Anglo-Saxons
English	We will continue to improve our story telling by Looking at the Anglo-Saxon story of Beowulf. The children will focus on the use of inverted commas, adverbials and their use of figurative language.
Mathematics	We will be learning to draw and interpret tables, bar and line graphs. Followed by a unit on fractions. Learning their times tables will help considerably when working out fraction of numbers.
Science	We will be finishing of our unit States of Matter, by completing 2 experiments. This will give the children a practical understanding of what they have learnt.
Computing	Our computing topic is called 'Making Games' we will design and make our own computer game in Scratch.
DT	We will be completing a food technology task linked to the Anglo-Saxons... more to be revealed nearer to the time.
History	We will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons, who they were, where they came from, where they settled and the impact they made on Great Britain.
RE	In R.E this half term we are learning about Hinduism and the significance of light vs dark.
PE	In PE we will be continuing with the dance unit and focusing on general fitness.
