


Year 2 Summer 2 2018



The final half term is often the busiest at school and there will be lots of events going on in Year 2 and across the school. Here is the outline of what your child will be learning about in their final half term. Alongside this, we will be spending some time doing work linked to football and the world cup. Year 2 have now finished their SATs test and we can't wait for swimming, our class assembly and much more fun learning!

	Theme: Beatrix Potter
English	During this half-term, we will be doing some more independent writing in a cross-curricular fashion. We will be writing alternative endings to Fantastic Mr Foxx, we will be writing about our Science experiments, as well as creating fact files about the Child of Hale and even football speeches for the World Cup!
Mathematics	We will be finishing off the remaining chapters in our Singapore Maths scheme which will include going over parts of every single section! This will be a fantastic way to ensure we have embedded our knowledge from throughout the whole year. We will also be doing lots of cross-curricular Maths through our theme and in Science too.
Science	Our Science topic this half-term with Mrs NGuzo will be mostly based around plants. However we will again be re-capping and going more in-depth in working scientifically across all of the Year 2 units.
Computing	This half term we will be focusing on coding and game making in Year 2, particularly using the software 'Scratch'. We will also be building on our Computing basic skills to ensure that we are ready for the juniors, which includes typing speed, saving and using different document makers.
Art and D&T	In Art we will be creating lots of different outcomes using a range of materials. We will be creating our own Child of Hale, designing England flags with a twist for the World Cup, as well as creating different types of Wild Animals in DT.
History	We will be looking into the history of the football World Cup, we will be learning more about the Child of Hale, as well as how the animal population has changed over

	the years.
Music	During music lessons this half term we will be focusing on rhythm and beats. We will be creating our own backing beats for football chants and creating our own using a range of instruments and other resources with our imaginative thinking!
RE	We will be looking at the purpose of role models and asking the questions who are their role models and who do we respect and why? This all links to the theme of the Church.
Geography	In Geography we will be looking into the location of the Child of Hale, as well as finding the locations of habitats for different animals. We will also be comparing countries that have football teams in the World Cup with where we live in England.
PE	This half term we will be doing a range of athletics and competitive sport in Year 2. We will also be swimming for two weeks in July.
