

Year 6 Summer 2 Half Term 2018

Here is an outline of what your child will be learning about this half term!

	Theme: A Midsummer Night's Dream
Article 12: You have the right to give your opinion, and for adults to listen and take it seriously.	
English	In English, we will be using a range of stimuli to generate a wide range of writing. We will focus on writing for a real purpose and a real audience where possible. Our focus text will be A Midsummer Night's Dream and we will be writing and performing play scripts.
Mathematics	In Maths, the children will be giving a wide range of opportunities to develop their ability to apply mathematical skills in real life contexts. Children will carry out investigative and project work where they need to utilise the most appropriate mathematical skills effectively. We will also be revisiting statistics, shape and measure.
Science	In Science, Year 6 will be developing their investigative skills by planning and carrying out a range of different investigations. Children will be given problems to solve and will have to work in small groups to solve the problems using their scientific knowledge.
Computing	In Computing, Year 6 will be building on their basic skills. This will include working on their typing skills and their knowledge of basic computer systems. Children will have the opportunity to create their own CV, build a website and present information in a variety of ways.
Geography	In Geography, Year 6 will be finding out about various countries involved in this year's World Cup. They will locate countries using maps and look at key physical and human characteristics, countries and major cities. The children will also use the 8

	points of a compass, 4 and 6 figure grid references, symbols and key to build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world.
Art/ Design and Technology	Year 6 will be designing and making scenery and props for their end of year play.
RE	Year 6 will be continuing to learn about Christian Values and asking the question 'What should our attitudes be on our journey?' We will continue to look at 'Life as a Journey' by looking at how people have different beliefs and some belong to different religions. This half term we will be finding out more about Islam.
PE	In PE, Year 6 will be playing competitive games, modified where appropriate in cricket, football, rounders and tennis and apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending. In preparation for the play, children will choreograph and perform dances using a range of movement patterns. Children will also take part in outdoor and adventurous activity challenges both individually and within a team.
