Here is the outline of what your child will be learning about this half term.

	Big Question: Where is the Greatest?
English	We will be revising spellings and grammar from Year3 and continuing to introduce new sentence types to improve our writing. We will be looking at the story of The BFG this half term. We will be creating character descriptions, newspaper reports, letters and much more!
Mathematics	In Maths, we are continuing with our length and perimeter as well as moving onto fractions. We will also cover mass and capacity. We will be focusing on times tables in particular our 4s and 8s as well as catching up on our 3s.
Science	Our science this half term is forces and magnets.
Computing	Our computing topic is called 'Keyboard Adventures' and we will be focusing on different skills when using a computer or tablet.
DT/Art	We have a DT focus of 'eating seasonally' this half term. We will spend time looking at climates and how foods grow as well as following recipes to cook and create our own food!
History/ Geography	We will be looking at the world's great physical features for our Geography this half term. We will recap the continents of the world and look at its most famous rivers, mountains and deserts as well as how they are all formed! It will help us to decide where is the greatest in the world.
RE	In R.E this half term we are looking at Jesus and the build up to Easter. We will look at the sacrifices Jesus made and how to give his life for us.
PE	In PE, we are completing our Football unit this half term as well as our two weeks developing our swimming skills.
