Key Facts

The **North** pole is known as the **Arctic**.

Animals living in the Arctic include; polar bears, sea otters, harp seals, walrus, arctic hares and narwhals

Native people who live in the Arctic are called Inuits.

The **South** pole is known as the **Antarctic**.

Animals found in the Antarctic are penguins, elephant seals, albatross and terns.

It is very cold in the Antarctic and people aren't able to live there. There are some research stations where scientists monitor the changing climate.
